



POLICY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

A travel and accommodation assistance grant program is available to registered trainees in gastroenterology residing in remote locations within Australia and its external territories.

The grant is to assist with the cost of attending events organised under the National Endoscopy Training Initiative (NETI) when advertising informs the applicant that financial assistance is available.

To qualify for consideration applicants must satisfy the following eligibility criteria:

- Be a registered trainee in gastroenterology;
- Have applied and been accepted to attend the event; and
- Reside in a remote/rural area where travel time is lengthy and expensive.

The assessment committee will make the final decision on those eligible taking into consideration the amount available for distribution, the number of applicants eligible and the merit of the application presented.

All applications must be received by the advertised closing date, late applications can not be considered.
